BEFORE READING!

Overview the whole selection.

- ✓ What do you know about the reading?
- ✓ What do you want to know?

Break the reading into sections.

How to Get Help From Your Group With Unfamiliar Words

1. Tell your group you NEED HELP!
 - with pronouncing a word
 - with the meaning of a word
2. What PAGE is the word is on and what LINE? (from the top, from the bottom)
3. READ THE SENTENCE where the word can be found – loudly!
4. Who KNOWS the word and can share?

Figure out the word from context.

OR

LOOK up the word if necessary.

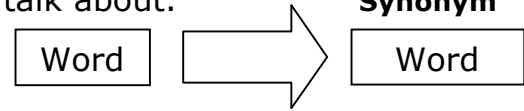
AFTER READING!

Figure out the main idea together. What is the author saying about your life?

Write the main idea or theme at the bottom of your paper.

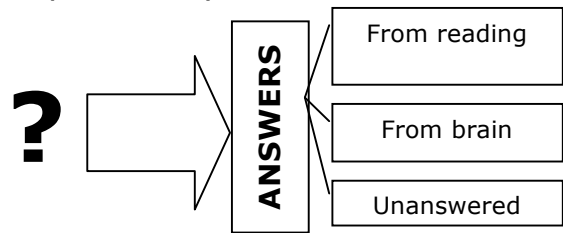
FOR EACH PART OF READING!

(1) Read the first section silently. Draw a box around any words you want to talk about. We need to agree on a synonym and write it above the word for the words we talk about.



FOR EACH PART OF READING!

(2) Read the section silently a second time. Mark and underline any questions you want to talk about.



FOR EACH PART OF READING!

(3) Read the section silently a THIRD time. WRITE a summary in the margin to show what the chunk is about.
